Qualifying Journey - 2 days and 1 night with at least 6 hours of activity during the day.

SILVER: Practice Journey - 2 1/2 days and 2 nights with 7 hours of activity during the day.
Qualifying Journey - 3 days and 2 nights with at least 7 hours of activity during the day.
