# BORLAND LODGE

# **INSTRUCTED ACTIVITIES**

## Abseiling

20m Fixed Site - Based on the Borland Rd this is a 10 minute drive from the lodge.

## Rock climbing

12m Fixed Site – Based on the Borland Rd 10 mins drive from the lodge. There are a variety of climbs available from super easy to difficult. 5m Indoor Climbing Wall – based indoors at Borland, this is a great all weather facility.

# Kayaking

Flat Water Kayaking – Based 10 mins drive from the lodge, this is a large safe pond with plenty of room for the students to explore while learning basic kayak skills.

# Caving

Based 30 mins from Borland Lodge, Clifden Caves offer groups a unique caving experience. For more information see www.doc.govt.nz/parksand-recreation/places-to-go/southland/places/ clifden-area

## **Ultimate Archery**

A cross between dodgeball and archery, this exhilarating game uses a bow and foam tipped arrows to eliminate your opponents. There are range of rule variations to bring out your competitive streak.

# ADULT SUPERVISED ACTIVITIES

## Low Ropes

Borland Lodge has a permanent low ropes course onsite made up of knee height elements designed to encourage team work and communication.

A selection of ground-based activities designed to challenge groups and encourage them to work as a team and think outside the square. This activity can be run inside or outside.

There is a great area for bivvy building/bush craft opposite the lodge.

# Orienteering

Borland Lodge has a permanent orienteering course in place. Markers range from within the lodge grounds to 1.5km away.

## Short Bush Walks

Scenic bush walks are available within a short walk of the lodge.

# **INSTRUCTED ACTIVITIES**

## Abseiling

9m rock face - Based 10 mins drive from the lodge.

# Rock climbing

4m bouldering wall – Based onsite at the lodge this wall can be used both for bouldering and climbing with ropes. The wall is undercover so is suitable for all weather.

# Kayaking

Estuary/River – Based 10 mins drive from the lodge. Kayaking is conducted on sit on top kayaks and held on flat water which allows the students to learn basic kayaking while getting to explore and have fun.

# High Confidence Course

The confidence course is based approx 5 mins from the lodge and is made up of a selection of elements ranging from knee height to 5m high. Adventure Southland will supply harnesses for this activity.

# ADULT SUPERVISED ACTIVITIES

All adult supervisors will receive a full activity briefing from Adventure Southland staff prior to running activities.

# High Confidence Course

The confidence course is based approx 5 mins from the lodge and is made up of a selection of elements ranging from knee height to 5m high. Adventure Southland will supply harnesses for this activity.

# Flying Fox

Based onsite at the lodge the flying fox is 40m long.

### **INSTRUCTED ACTIVITIES**

#### Abseiling

12m tree – Based onsite at the camp. The 12m abseil tree gives students a chance to try abseiling in a very unique but safe environment.

## Kayaking

Beach/Natural Pool – Based 5 mins walk from the Omaui camp. With the ever changing environment, Omaui now offers beach kayaking along with flat water kayaking in their natural salt/tidal pools. Kayaking is conducted on sit-on top kayaks, allowing students to learn basic kayak skills while having fun.

## **Bush Walking/Orienteering**

Instructors can take bush walking groups, which start at the camp and make their way up Omaui Hill. During the walk, basic plant identification is taught, and at the top of the hill the group splits into smaller groups and follow a short orienteering/navigation course back to the assembly point.

# **INSTRUCTED ACTIVITIES**

All activities at Adventure Southland are instructed by our friendly staff. Some activities do have size and weight limitations. Our staff will advise you about these during the booking process.

## Field Archery

We have an archery range set up adjacent to our ropes course, offering two lanes and distances up to 30 metres, there is plenty of scope for personal challenge or friendly competition.

# **Ultimate Archery**

A cross between dodgeball and archery, this exhilarating game uses a bow and foam tipped arrows to eliminate your opponents. There are range of rule variations to bring out your competitive streak.

## Low Ropes

We have 9 different knee height low ropes elements designed to promote team work and communication.

# ABL (Adventure Based Learning)

This is a selection of ground-based activities designed to challenge groups and encourage them to work as a team and think outside the square. This activity can be run inside or outside.

# Teambuilding/Initiative Course

Similar to ABL but using fixed apparatus, this course is designed to encourage team building, communication and thinking outside the box to solve a series of problems based at ground level.

# High Ropes

Made up of various different challenges and reaching heights of up to 12m our high ropes course is designed to test everyone in a safe and fun environment.

# **Rock Climbing**

Our outdoor climbing wall offers 6 different climbs ranging of varying difficulties. The Adventure Southland climbing wall is a great introduction to climbing in a controlled environment.

# Abseiling

Standing at 12m high, our abseil tower allows students to face their fears and explore their personal limits.

# Flying Fox

Starting off on a 12m high ledge, the flying fox allows you to soar over the grounds of Adventure Southland for 65metres. (Weight/size limits apply).

# Flying Weka

The flying weka is a great team building activity which involves using team work to pull one team member up into the air allowing them to "fly" whilst attached via a harness. The team member then re-joins the group and someone else becomes the "Weka".

# **Giant Swing**

No visit to Adventure Southland is complete without experiencing the giant swing. We will leave the rest to your imagination. (Weight/size limits apply).
